FAMILIARISATION (Favourite word of the day (5))

THE MIND - NO INSTRUMENT

Familiarise yourself with:

- Key signature
- Tempo
- Length of piece
- Structure
- Difficult parts
- Intention of sound
- Intention of expression

THE BODY - NO INSTRUMENT

Familiarise yourself with:

- GENERAL
 - Your breath (forgot to talk about this sorry! Breath deep and calmly, and don't hold your breath)
 - o The floor
 - Your shoulders
 - o Your arms
 - Your hands
- LEFT HAND/PICK UP INSTRUMENT
 - Draw circles
 - Scooping up and back down, being bold
 - Wiggle fingers aaaaaand drop!
- RIGHT HAND/PICK UP BOW
 - Paint
 - o Flop
 - o Let go with left hand and balance
- PICK UP BOTH INSTRUMENT AND BOW
 - O Now wait and bob and feel weight of both

- SEPARATE OUT LEFT AND RIGHT HAND
 - Create sound without worrying at ALL about the left hand
 - Work out left hand without worrying about sound
- IGNORE VIBRATO, RHYTHM, AND SOUND WHEN ONLY FOCUSED ON LEFT HAND
 - Only be concerned with:
 - Intonation
 - left hand relaxation and comfort
 - left hand clarity

PATIENCE - THE ART OF SLOW PRACTICE

NOW LET'S GO SO SO SLOWLY

- Patience is key
- Keep breathing as you're doing stuff that's really slow
- Keep shaking out your body
- Put down the instrument if you get impatient and angsty

GENERAL BITS OF ADVICE

- Anything that's really difficult that takes a lot of concentration DO NOT DO FOR LONG
- Don't allow yourself to get disheartened or disappointed. This is NOT EASY!
- Keep focused on the bigger picture and do not get down about small problems
- Stay focused, and if you're getting distracted stop and start again
